IMPORTANT NOTES FOR TEACHERS AND STUDENTS

Teachers, please advise your students to:

1. Bring to the Fair any **application items** or **corrections** missing from your entry.
2. Make the **Project Abstract** easy for judges to read. It may be mounted on a vertical surface or placed on the table-top space, or you may wish to create handouts of the Abstract.
3. Be **present and available** at exhibits throughout the Fair.
4. Prepared project presentations must be limited to **5 minutes** during Judging.
5. **Bring lunch** in a closed container, or plan to **purchase lunch** in the SAC. You **must** leave the exhibit hall to eat. Thank you!
